Type **education.nsw.gov.au** in the address bar of your web browser window and press enter/return on your keyboard. Then click Log in(1) followed by Student portal(2).

1.Type your firstname.lastname and number if you have one after your last name.

Eg sam.brown30 or linda.green etc

Your username and password is the same as your Premier's reading challenge password.

2. Press tab or click in the password box(field) to type your password.

3. Click on the button

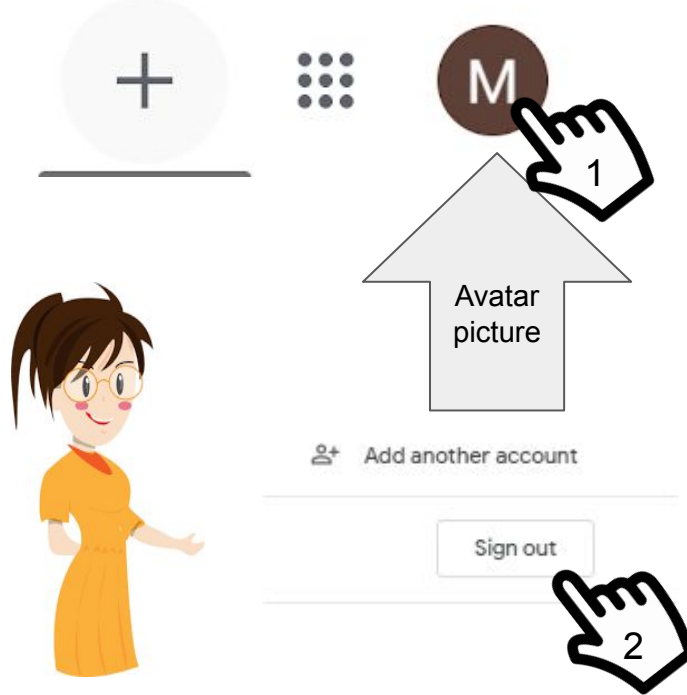
Click on Classroom

If your avatar is not showing, click on the avatar you can see(1) and **sign out** (2) the other Google account user. To work with Google Education you need to be signed into your student Google account.



An avatar is a graphic representation. Like this teacher avatar on this page.

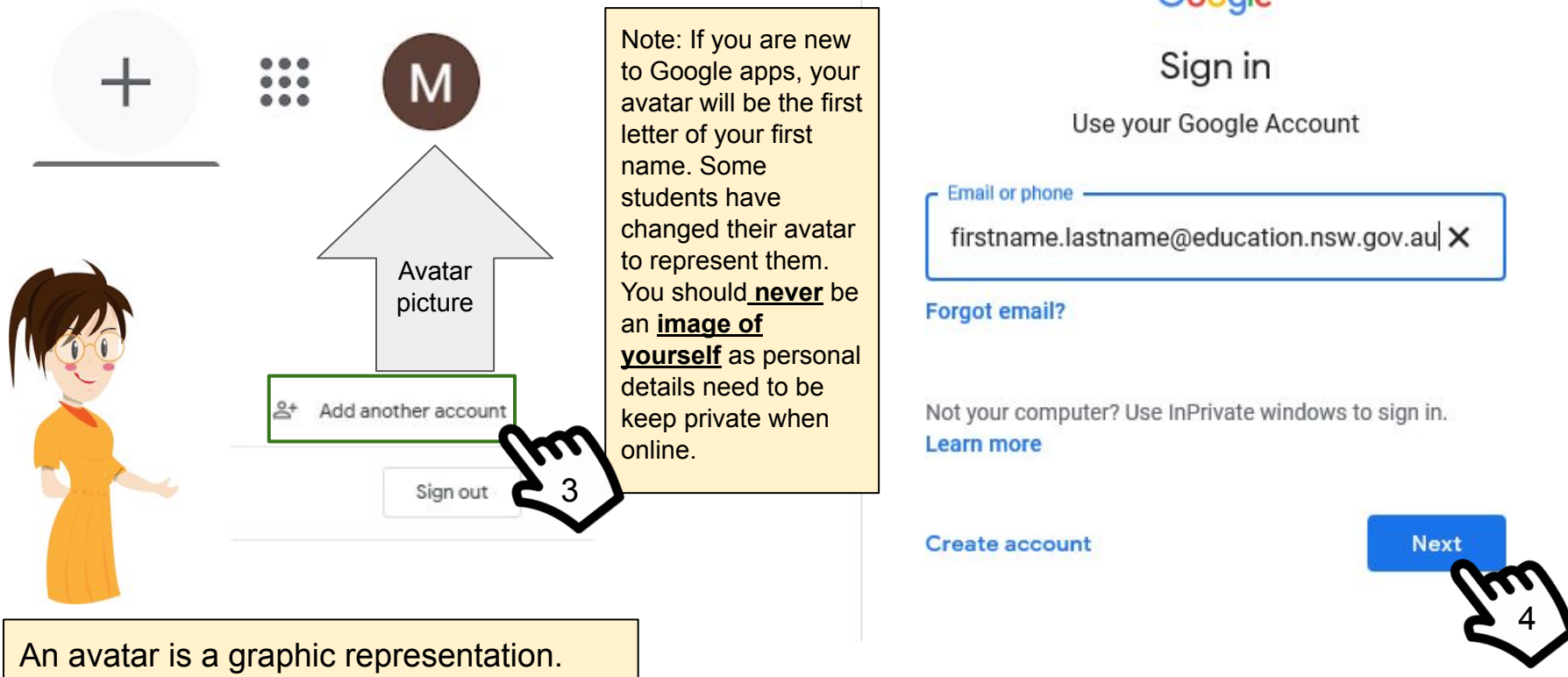

Click **add another account**(3) to add your account if your account isn't on the list of accounts.

You will need to type your email address which is

firstname.lastname@education.nsw.gov.au (4)

Note: Don't forget to also add the number if you have a number as part of your student login
