

SCHOOL READINESS

Being ready means you are equipped with the basic skills to deal with what lies ahead, making the transition to school smooth and giving students a stronger foundation on which to build their educational future.

Emotional - This is about children being able to recognise their feelings and manage their behaviour. Can they regulate their emotions to cope with stress, develop stronger relationships with peers, negotiate effectively with other children and have a positive sense of self? Is your child confident, independent and can they express themselves?

Social — This is about children following simple directions, getting along with their peers, controlling their emotions in a classroom setting, engaging in social conversation and cooperative play.

Physical - This is about the development of gross motor skills, which involves whole body movement and their fine motor skills, which involves the coordination of small muscle movements. Can your child independently toilet themselves and look after their own belongings?

Intellectual - Can your child recognise their name? Is your child interested in stories? Can your child complete a simple puzzle? Can your child follow a simple instruction? e.g. Put the cup on the table.

ENROLMENT PROCEDURES

- ► All children must be in compulsory schooling by their 6th birthday.
- ► Children can start Kindergarten next year if they turn 5 on or before 31 July 2023.
- Students should start school at the beginning of the school year.


